It doesn't matter whether you have rental investments or a trading business running through your LAQC - **the change in law will affect you.**

As you may be aware, the Government has a keen interest in tying up anything seen to be a tax "loophole" and removing the LAQC status is one such thing that will change from 1 April 2011.

Legislation has now been passed. We have a short window of opportunity to actively decide what your next step should be - should you become a Look-Through Company (LTC), a sole trader, a partnership, QC or simply a standard company?

These are all options that need to be considered in light of your specific circumstances. A number of things need to be taken into account before you take the next step including, when you want to cash up on your investments, how you are currently financed and the impact of the law changes around depreciation, to name but a few.

Within the next month, we will contact you to arrange a convenient time to consider your options and to advise you on your best course of action. In order to do this, we will need you to complete a questionnaire before our meeting.

Even if "doing nothing" is what you want to do, it needs to be a well-informed conscious choice made with the aim of protecting your financial interests and maximising your return.

If you file your own Annual Return, remember it is your responsibility to ensure Company records are up date and comply with the regulations. The government has tightened rules around Company Directors and Registration, information can be found on the Companies Office website.

Also be aware that in June of last year the Companies Office drastically changed the look and functionality of their website. You may need a new login and will want to use that login well in advance to make sure you are comfortable with the new procedures.
